# **Asset Management: Definition**

Asset Management incorporates the entire life cycle of an asset, from the time that asset is ordered until the time it is replaced or decommissioned. The goal with Asset Management is to maximize the asset's benefits based upon its performance.

# **Reliability: Definition**

**Reliability** is the ability of an asset to fulfil expectations about its functionality. Therefore, a reliable asset functions to consistent expectations. It also meets all legal requirements, delivers the performance required to meet business goals, and is supported by a proactive culture. How do asset management and reliability compliment each other?
